앨범『Escape』의 오프닝 넘버, 기타는 ①부분에서 페이드 앤하고 있다. 이 프레이즈는 세크가 필요하다. 피킹은 울터네 이트(업과 다운의 반복), 오른손 세끼손가락의 밀 언저리로 가볍게 유트한다. 제업한 프레이즈라고 말할 수 있다. 프레이즈 와 같은 악보에 너무 구애받지 않고, 복잡아지는 느낌이 나면 좋을 것이다. ②의 Gt-1 배경은 개방현의 큐트가 중요하므로 오른손을 잘 사용할 것. ③는 솔로, 첫 시작의 반을 초킹은 약 손가락으로 하는 것인데, 힘이 들어가지 않도록 주의할 것. 확

실히 반유의 음정을 내자. Intro의 베이스는 다소 뉘앙스를 바꾸거나 약간 장난끼가 들어가 있는 느낌이다. 피아노나 기타와 유니즌에 가까운 상태이므로 너무 심하게 동떨어지게 해서는 안된다. 드럼은 심플한 8비트의 패턴이 중심. ④ 등에서는 풀 심벌즈의 컵의 음을 잘 섞은 드레이밍이 흥미롭다. 키보드는 Intro부터 ⑤까지 쭉 같은 피아노의 패턴. ⑥부터는 약간 샤프한 음색의 신다사이저에 의한 배경. 전체적으로는 어렵지 않음으로 트라이하기 쉬울 것이다. 코러스에도 꼭 도전해 보자.
